Medway Council and Medway Voice are running some **free workshops in September 2011** to support local people and communities.

These 'Community Champions' workshops are **aimed at community organisations, local groups and clubs, as well as individual residents**. If you are already helping to make your local neighbourhood, or Medway generally, a better place to live, these workshops are intended for you. They are also open to anyone who would like to get more involved in community activities or volunteering opportunities locally. These workshops are our way of recognising the important role that people like you play (for which there may often be little acknowledgement or thanks) by providing support through informative and interactive sessions.

There are **different topics covering key skills**, such as budgeting, managing people, promoting events and fundraising. We are not expecting you to do anything after attending a workshop, except to make use of what you have learned and put it into practice, so that you and/or your organisation/group can do even more great things locally.

You are invited to **come along to as many or as few workshops as you like**. Topics include:

Fundraising: Find out what grants may be available to help fund your group or activity and how to improve your chances of a making successful grant application.

Sharing the workload: How to build an effective team and work to people's strengths, as well as some top tips on budgeting and banking.

Organising successful events: How to plan and prepare for your event, what sort of help and resources you'll need and how to promote your event.

Tools to build your community: What you need to know if you are running a voluntary or community group or you want to set one up. Plus, what the Government's Localism agenda and Big Society mean for local people.

We want you to be really successful, so please do **take this opportunity to ask questions, share ideas and get hints and tips, information and advice**.
